Aims and Objectives



- 1) To enhance community and social cohesion through activities which benefit both individual and their local surroundings
- 2) To promote ecological attitudes, wellness practices and empowerment in London, and in UK inner cities.
- 3) To make information and research garnered from works available to communities internationally
- 4) To promote and make possible ecological projects, actualising ecological values, living ecological lifestyles and making active connections with the natural environment.
- 5) To be in harmony with nature
- 6) To promote the synthesis of science and technology with wisdom and caring toward our planet
- 7) To promote awareness of different groups in the community who are vulnerable, with an emphasis on empowerment and mutual gain rather than pity
- 8) To educate about ways in which healthcare can commonly be supported using basic principles of nature and to reflect upon our native origins and global heritage in healthcare practice
- 9) To educate and continually learn about the wisdom of different cultures and the useful integration of varieties of perspective, knowledge and multicultural sciences
- 10) To educate on the unification of knowledge and of lifestyle practice as opposed to the separatism of nationality or race/origin
- 11) To promote empowerment through learning about human rights, individual and collective responsibilities, inalienable rights and birthrights
- 12) To promote the equal and fair sharing of earth resources with all creatures
- 13) To promote the equal and fair sharing of human made produce between people- with an emphasis on local birthrights for peoples all over the world
- 14) To promote peace upon the planet
- 15) To create activities, information booklets, events, web resources and to distribute other groups materials
- 16) To catalyze; campaigns, aid work projects, and lawful actions for the betterment of natural people, the planet and all life on earth
- 17) To expose injustice
- 18) To act as a support service to campaign organisations or any platform from which to express protest to any corporate driven or manmade event which negatively impacts the peaceable enjoyment of natural environments or the natural birthrights of peoples, as deemed compulsory by international law
- 19) To make change and to continually strive for inner evolution and positive development
- 20) To promote the acceptance and integration of all levels within individuals beings- Mind-body-spirit-soul-emotion-ego-shadow-universal-earthly: culminating understanding as to the multifaceted holistic existence we all live in, and to promote related pathways to community happiness, peaceable enjoyment and enrichment through whatever skills, interests and gifts individuals have to offer
- 21) To promote a gift/ time share economy
- 22) To promote and facilitate mutual support in individual and group projects
- 23) To act as a network for people striving to achieve a balance between the cultivation and development of inner peace and success with the struggle and/ or striving toward healing people and planet
- 24) Should Welkin Earth cease activity, all available funds would be passed onto partner organisations with similar aims, with organisation and funds allocations voted by members of Welkin Earth at that time.
